APPLICABILITY

This Policy applies to UNM Health Sciences Center academic units.

POLICY RATIONALE

(B2, 2.3) These appointments are non-tenure-track faculty titles. <u>The continuing nature of these</u> <u>appointments and the required notice for termination are determined by the individual</u> <u>contract.</u>

POLICY STATEMENT

1. Clinician-Educator Faculty

(B2, 2.3) In the Health Sciences Center, faculty may be appointed to the position of clinicianeducator. These appointments are for health professionals with appropriate professional degrees <u>a</u> <u>MD degree, a Ph.D. degree, or an equivalent doctoral degree (see definition below)</u> (B2, 2.3) who are primarily engaged in patient care and teaching and may have related scholarly responsibilities. While not eligible for tenure, clinician-educators may hold the rank of instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or professor.

2. Practitioner-Educator Faculty

(B2, 2.3) In the Health Sciences Center faculty may be appointed to the position of <u>practitioner-educator</u>. These appointments are for healthcare professionals who: <u>possess the terminal degree in</u> <u>their field of study</u>

1) possess the graduate or equivalent degrees required for entry into practice, as designated by the appropriate credentialing bodies in their field,

<u>2) do not possess an MD degree, a Ph.D. degree, or an equivalent doctoral degree, and</u>
<u>3)</u> who are primarily engaged in patient care and teaching and may have related scholarly responsibilities.

While not eligible for tenure, <u>practitioner-educators</u> may hold the rank of instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or professor.

3. Continuing Non-Tenure-Track Appointments

(B3, 3.4.1) Clinician-educator <u>and practitioner-educator</u> appointments are for a fixed term, subject to renewal at the discretion of the dean, following policies and procedures adopted by colleges in the Health Sciences Center.

Revisions to the remaining sections of this document may be amended with the approval of the Academic Freedom and Tenure Committee and UNM Faculty.

DEFINITIONS

Equivalent doctoral degree is defined as any relevant doctoral degree which includes but is not limited to Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD), Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS), Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP), Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD), Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD), Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT), Doctor of Public Health (DrPH), Doctor of Social Work (DSW), and Doctor of Speech Language Pathology (SLPD); MD equivalent degrees include Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) and Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO).

Healthcare Professionals is defined as those employed by or working at UNM (either inside or outside UNM Health and Health Sciences) while providing health care.

Patient Care is defined by a need for a patient care license. The patient care and teaching must occur at the behest of UNM.
